Term 2

Term 2 is busy for our VCE students. It includes end of Unit deadlines, Year 10/11 Exams, VCE Excursions, sporting events, Debutante ball, Work experience, the GAT, and SACs in all classes. All of these squeezed into a 9 week term.

Some of the important dates include:

Thursday June 13th – Final Unit 1 deadline. All Unit 1 work must be completed by this date.

Note that there are only 8 weeks of Unit 1 classes. All classes will have SACs and outcome tasks to complete. All Unit 1 work needs to be submitted to a satisfactory standard, and authenticated, by 4pm on Thursday, June 13th.

VCE Attendance

A reminder that all VCE classes have an 80% attendance requirement for satisfactory completion. Students may drop below the 80% requirement for approved absences – medical certificates are required for absences due to illness. If a student misses a SAC, they need to provide evidence (eg medical certificate) for the SAC to be graded.
