Presentation Night




Rotary Schoolies Alternative 2018 - Cambodia Experience Final Report:

Below is an account of the group's movement from their blog....

Tabitha Foundation has been supporting Cambodians since the mid 1990's. Janne Ritskes and her team have developed a great program providing savings plans, the chance to develop sustainable financial resources, clean drinking water and the opportunity to have a home - ironically, all the things we take for granted in the West. When families have nothing, life ahead can seem hopeless. Tabitha helps families and communities to develop hope and a future with purpose.

The group had the opportunity to provide on thing we all take for granted, a house, to 8 families in Kandal Province. This day accounted for the largest part of our fundraising efforts.

Teneille's thoughts: 'An early start for all the team members to be on the way to our area for house building. Two hours on the bus and we finally reached our destination, we were divided into 4 groups and each group had to do the floors and walls on 2 houses. All up we completed 8 houses as a team, with the help of some locals some of the housed were done very quickly and we saw some interesting ways of putting nails in with some using an axe and one even using his hands! The families of the houses were very thankful and appreciative of our efforts in giving them a house. At the end of our building we had a presentation where we gave each family a blanket made by the ladies at Tabitha. Overall we had a good time and a very different experience which made us so grateful for every-

NEW FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP FOR REGIONAL STUDENTS

In early October the Australian Federal Government announced a new financial support scheme for students living in rural, regional and remote Australia to study science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) courses.

Eligible students can access up to \$18,000 towards the cost of studying at university or a vocational education and training institution through the \$24 million Rural and Regional Enterprise Scholarships program which is now open.
