#### **Accelerated Studies**

In line with the VCE timetable, all year 10 subjects run for a combined five periods per week. This is designed to allow capable and organized students the possibility of studying some VCE subjects and/or VET programs.

Undertaking a VCE unit in Year 10 has significant advantages such as:

- The opportunity to develop academic and study skills in readiness for VCE
- The possibility of completing a 3-4 sequence in Year 11 and therefore having six study scores to contribut to their ATAR at the end of Year 12.

Student preference is a high priority in deciding which courses finally run. However, the following factors must also be taken into account:

- Staffing—both the total number of staff and the availability of staff with particular specialist qualifications
- Rooms—many programs require the use of specialist rooms, at least for some class time

### **Work Experience**

Work experience is an exciting part of the Year 10 curriculum. All Year 10s complete work experience in either Term 3 or Term 4.
