MINISTERIAL ORDER 1280 EDUCATION AND TRAINING REFORM ACT 2006

CONSTITUTION OF GOVERNMENT SCHOOL COUNCILS

(*Version incorporating amendments as at 09 September 2020*)

Part 1 – Preliminary

1. Name

This Order is called the **Ministerial Order (Constitution of Government School Councils) 2020**.

2. Authorising provisions and commencement

- (1) This Order is made under Part 2.3 and Division 3 of Part 5.10 of the Act.
- (2) This Order comes into operation on 1 January 2021.

3. Objectives

The objectives of this Order are to:

- (a) set out the role and accountabilities of Victorian Government school councils in a new consolidated Order;
- (b) provide for the constitution of new school councils for Government schools as bodies corporate;
- (c) provide for the continuation of existing school councils as bodies corporate in accordance with this Order:
- (d) make provision for or with respect to the membership of school councils;
- (e) confer or impose on school councils (or particular members of school councils) powers, duties, and functions in addition to those conferred or imposed by or under the Act:
- (f) make other provisions in relation to the constitution, powers, duties, and functions of school councils, including limiting or regulating the exercise of those powers, duties and functions: and
- (g) revoke specified Ministerial Orders relating to school councils.

4. Interpretation

(1) In this Order:

Act means the Education and Training Reform Act 2006;

authorised appointer, in relation to a nominee member school council, means the person or body authorised to appoint a member to the nominee member category of the school council under clause 15;

commencement date means the date this order comes into operation under clause 2(2);

community member means a school council member co-opted or appointed by the school council as a community member;

date of the declaration of the poll, in relation to an election, means the date on which the principal formally declares candidates for the school council to be elected under clause 17 of Schedule 6;

Department employee:

- (a) means a person employed:
 - (i) under Part 2.4 of the Act or by the Secretary under the **Public Administration Act 2004**; or
 - (ii) for eight hours or more per week in either an ongoing capacity or for a fixed term of at least 90 days;
- (b) includes a person employed by a school council of a Government school for eight hours or more per week in either an ongoing capacity or for a fixed term of at least 90 days; but
- (c) does not include a person engaged only as a contractor (or an employee, agent, or contractor of a person engaged as a contractor);

electorate of the school means, as the case requires:

- (a) the school employee electorate of the school;
- (b) the parent electorate of the school;
- (c) the secondary school student electorate of the school;

existing school council means a school council continued under clause 6;

first school council election means the first school council election held after the school council is constituted;

membership category means one of the categories of members set out in clause 7;

nominee member means a school council member appointed by an authorised appointer under clause 15;

nominee member school council means a school council listed in Schedule 4;

notice of election and call for nominations, in relation to an election, means the notice made in accordance with clause 3 of Schedule 6;

parent electorate of the school means all persons who are:

- (a) parents of students of the school; but
- (b) not in the school employee electorate of the school;

parent member means a school council member elected from and by, or co-opted from, the parent electorate of the school;

Procurement Policy for Victorian Government Schools means the policy on school council procurement matters issued by the Department (and amended from time to time);

public reporting meeting means a public meeting of the school council conducted under regulation 37 of the *Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017* at which the school council:

- (a) reports on the council's proceedings since the previous public reporting meeting;
- (b) presents the council's annual report; and
- (c) if applicable, presents a copy of the council's audited accounts;

school means the Government school or schools in respect of which the school council is constituted:

school employee electorate of the school means:

- (a) the principal of the school; and
- (b) each Department employee who is engaged in work at and for the school;

school employee member means:

- (a) a school council member elected from and by, or co-opted from, the school employee electorate of the school; and
- (b) the principal as an ex officio member of the school council;

secondary school student electorate of the school means all students of the school enrolled in year 7 or above;

student member means a school council member elected from and by, or co-opted from, the secondary school student electorate of the school;

variable membership category means one of the categories of members set out in clause 8(1).

- (2) In this Order, if a school council has been constituted for two or more schools:
 - (a) a reference to the principal is to be taken to be a reference to co-principals (if any); and
 - (b) any power, function, or duty conferred on a principal may be exercised or performed jointly and severally by the co-principals.
- (3) For the purposes of Part 3 and Schedule 6, any person on any form of leave from employment with the Department (including secondment), whether with or without pay, is considered:
 - (a) while on leave, to have the Department employee status they had immediately before going on leave; and
 - (b) if the leave is for a period of six months or less, to remain a member of any Department employee electorate of which they were a member immediately before going on leave.

Notes:

Interpretation

A. This Order is a subordinate instrument under the Act. This Order uses many terms that are defined in the Act. Under section 23 of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**, expressions used in a

subordinate instrument have the same respective meanings as they have in the Act under which they are made. For this reason, this Order does not define terms such as *Department*, *Government school*, *parent*, *principal*, and *Secretary*.

Forms

B. This Order prescribes a number of forms for various purposes, such as forms to be used in school council elections. A failure to observe strict compliance with requirements for a prescribed form is unlikely to make the form (and anything done under or through it) invalid: see section 53 of the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**, which provides that "[w]here a form is *prescribed by* an Act or *subordinate instrument* for any purpose, any form in or to the like effect of the prescribed form shall, unless the contrary intention appears, be sufficient in law" (emphasis added).

Part 2 – New and existing school councils

5. Constitution of new school councils

- (1) For the purposes of section 2.3.2 of the Act, there is to be constituted as a body corporate a school council with the name referred to in column 1 of Table A in Schedule 1 in respect of the Government school or schools referred to in the corresponding row in column 2 of that Table.
- (2) A school council constituted under subclause (1) may exercise and discharge the powers, duties, and functions conferred or imposed on it by or under the Act including by Part 4 of the *Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017* and this Order.

6. Continuation of existing school councils

- (1) This clause applies to a school council that:
 - (a) is identified in column 1 of Table B in Schedule 1;
 - (b) was constituted as a body corporate under Part 2.3 of the Act or under the **Education Act 1956** (repealed); and
 - (c) immediately before the commencement of this order, was constituted in relation to the Government school or schools referred to in the corresponding row in column 2 of that table.
- (2) A school council to which this clause applies is continued in existence as the same body corporate in relation to the same Government school or schools.
- (3) A school council continued under this clause may exercise and discharge the powers, duties and functions conferred or imposed on it by or under the Act including by Part 4 of the *Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017* and this Order.

Part 3 – Membership of school councils

Division 1 – Members and membership categories

7. School council membership

- (1) Subject to this Part, a school council consists of:
 - (a) parent members;
 - (b) school employee members (including the principal);
 - (c) community members;
 - (d) if the school has students enrolled in Year 7 or above, student members; and
 - (e) if the school is a nominee member school council, nominee members.
- (2) The principal of the school is an ex officio member of the school council.

Note: See also section 2.3.7 of the Act, which provides that the principal is the executive officer of the school council.

8. Variable membership categories for school councils

- (1) The variable membership categories for a school council are:
 - (a) the parent member category;
 - (b) the school employee member category;
 - (c) the community member category; and
 - (d) if the school is a nominee member school council, the nominee member category.
- (2) The size and composition of the variable membership categories of the school council are those specified in column 4 of Tables A and B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.
- (3) The Minister may approve a change to the total number of members or the composition of the school council in accordance with:
 - (a) Divisions 2 and 3 of this Part; and
 - (b) the options for size and composition specified in Schedule 2.

Division 2 – Size and composition of a school council

9. Total number of members

The total variable membership of a school council must not exceed the number listed under the letter "V" specified for that school council in column 4 of Table A or Table B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.

10. Parent member category

(1) The number of members in the parent member category must not exceed the number listed under the letter "P" specified for that school council in column 4 of Table A or Table B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.

(2) Subject to the general eligibility requirements in clause 17, any person in the parent electorate of the school is eligible for election to the parent member category.

11. School employee member category

- (1) The number of members in the school employee member category (including the principal) must not exceed the number listed under the letter "E" specified for that school council in column 4 of Table A or Table B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.
- (2) Subject to the general eligibility requirements in clause 17, any person in the school employee electorate of the school (other than the principal) is eligible for election to the school employee member category.

12. Community member category

- (1) The number of members in the community member category must not exceed the number of members listed under the letters "CO" specified for that school council in column 4 of Table A or Table B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.
- (2) Subject to the general eligibility requirements in clause 17, any person other than a Department employee may be co-opted to the community member category.
- (3) Community members may be co-opted by the school council for the period up to the declaration of the poll in the second calendar year following the year of their co-option.

13. Student member category

- (1) The number of members in the student member category for a school council of a school other than an exempt school is two.
- (2) For the purpose of subclause (1), an exempt school means:
 - (a) a school that only provides primary school education;
 - (b) a school listed in Schedule 3; or
 - (c) a school in relation to which the Secretary has granted an exemption in accordance with clause 14.
- (3) Subject to the general eligibility requirements in clause 17, any person in the secondary school student electorate of the school is eligible for election to the student member category except a student who is enrolled at the school and at Parkville College.

14. Exemption from the requirement to have student members

- (1) A school council may apply to the Secretary for an exemption from the requirement to have two student members on the school council.
- (2) An application under subclause (1) must:
 - (a) be made in the form approved by the Secretary;
 - (b) be made no later than the end of term 4 of the school year before the school year to which the exemption relates; and
 - (c) comply with the requirements of the Secretary's exemption policy.
- (3) If an application is made in accordance with subclause (2), the Secretary must determine the application, by granting or refusing to grant an exemption, no later than the beginning of term 1 in the school year to which the exemption relates.

- (4) The Secretary may grant an exemption if the Secretary is satisfied it is appropriate to do so because:
 - (a) the school is a small school, a rural school, a special school; or
 - (b) other exceptional circumstances exist that justify granting the exemption.
- (5) If the Secretary grants an exemption, the exemption operates for the period specified in the exemption (unless earlier revoked).
- (6) In this clause:

small school means a school (other than a school listed in Schedule 3) with less than 30 students enrolled in year 7 and above;

special school means a school (other than a school listed in Schedule 3) established for the main purpose of providing instruction for:

- (a) students with disabilities; or
- (b) students with social, emotional or behavioural difficulties.

15. Nominee members

- (1) This clause applies to nominee member school councils, being the councils specified in column 1 of the table in Schedule 4.
- (2) The number of members in the nominee member category of a school council must not exceed the number listed under the letter "N" specified for that school in column 4 of Table A or Table B (as the case requires) in Schedule 1.
- (3) A person or body listed in column 2 of the table in Schedule 4 is authorised to appoint a person to the nominee member category of the school council in accordance with the requirements set out in column 3 of the table in Schedule 4.
- (4) Subject to the general eligibility requirements in clause 17, a person is eligible for appointment to a nominee member category if they meet the requirements for nomination set out in column 3 of the table in Schedule 4.

16. General rules applying to membership categories

- (1) School employee members must not comprise more than one third of a school council's total variable membership.
- (2) The majority of a school council's total membership must be persons who are not Department employees.
- (3) In accordance with subclause (2), the total number of Department employees who may be members of a school council in any membership category must not exceed the number specified in Schedule 2, having regard to the school council's size and composition.
- (4) If a school council is not a nominee member school council:
 - (a) parent members must comprise at least one third of the school council's total variable membership; and

- (b) the total number of Department employees who may be members of the parent member category is equal to the "Maximum Department employee parents" specified in Schedule 2.
- (5) If a school council is a nominee member school council:
 - (a) at least one third of the school council's total variable membership must comprise parent members, nominee members, or community members; and
 - (b) the total number of Department employees who may be members of the parent member category (if any) is equal to the "Maximum Department employee parents" specified in Schedule 2 minus the number of nominee members that are Department employees.

17. General eligibility requirements

A person is ineligible for election or co-option as a school council member if the person:

- (a) is or has been an insolvent under administration;
- (b) is of unsound mind;
- (c) has been found guilty or convicted of an indictable offence or an offence that would be an indictable offence if it had been committed in Victoria;
- (d) is a registrable offender within the meaning of the **Sex Offenders Registration Act 2004**; or
- (e) is subject to any medical condition that would make them unable to fulfil the role of a member of school council.

Division 3 – Variation to membership categories

18. Application to vary the membership of the school council

- (1) A school council may apply to the Minister to change the council's membership size or composition once in any 12-month period.
- (2) An application to change the council's size or composition may propose a change or changes to:
 - (a) the school employee member category;
 - (b) the parent member category;
 - (c) the community member category; or
 - (d) if the school is a nominee school, the nominee member category.
- (3) A proposed change to the size and composition:
 - (a) must be consistent with the options for size and composition specified in Schedule 2 of this Order;
 - (b) must be approved by:
 - (i) at least 75% of school council members (excluding student members); or

- (ii) if special circumstances exist, no less than 50% of school council members; and
- (c) must not result in a total variable council membership of more than 15, or less than 6, members.
- (4) An application under subclause (2):
 - (a) must be made in:
 - (i) the form set out in Schedule 5; or
 - (ii) if it relates to the nominee member category (if any), a form approved by the Secretary;
 - (b) must identify the membership category or categories that are to be increased or decreased;
 - (c) if it is proposed to decrease the number of community members, must identify the member or members whose positions will be eliminated;
 - (d) if it is proposed to decrease the number of school employee members or the number of parent members, must indicate whether the decrease is to apply to the whole membership category or only those members whose terms of office expire on a specified date;
 - (e) if it is proposed to increase the number of nominee members, must specify the proposed appointer(s) and the proposed conditions of appointment; and
 - (f) if it is proposed to decrease the number of nominee members, must identify the position(s) and appointer(s) affected.

19. Variation of membership categories

Increase of the school employee or parent member category

- (1) If the Minister approves an application to increase the number of school employee members or parent members:
 - (a) the school council may fill any resulting vacancy by co-opting a person who is eligible for election to the membership category; and
 - (b) the new position or positions are to be allocated one- or two-year terms of office such that the terms of office for the total membership category are distributed as evenly as is possible.

Decrease of the community member category

(2) If the Minister approves an application to decrease the number of community members or nominee members, the affected positions are eliminated on the date specified by the Minister.

Decrease of the school employee or parent member category

- (3) If the Minister approves an application under clause 18(4)(d) to decrease the number of school council members in the school employee member or parent member category and the result is that the number of current members exceeds the new approved number, the council must hold a runoff election among the affected members on a date:
 - (a) fixed in accordance with clause 2 of Schedule 6;

- (b) as soon as practicable after the Minister approves the application to decrease the size of the category.
- (4) The term of office of any person elected under subclause (3):
 - (a) commences on the day after the date of the declaration of the poll for the election; and
 - (b) ends on the date as determined in accordance with clause 20(2) and (3).
- (5) In subclause (1):
 - (a) a "one-year term of office" means a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the first calendar year following the year of the co-option;
 - (b) a "**two-year term of office**" means a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the second calendar year following the year of the co-option.

Division 4 – Terms of office

20. Terms of office – first school council election

- (1) This clause applies to:
 - (a) all school employee and parent members elected at the first council election; and
 - (b) all community members co-opted by the council following the first council election.
- (2) If the number of members elected or co-opted to a membership category is:
 - (a) an even number, half of their number is to serve a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the first calendar year following the year of the election and half is to serve a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the second calendar year following the year of the election;
 - (b) an odd number, half of their number minus 1 (i.e. (the number of members -1)/2) are to serve a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the first calendar year following the year of the election and the remainder are to serve a term of office that ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election in the second calendar year following the year of the election.
- (3) For the purposes of subclause (2):
 - (a) if all the members in a membership category were elected by ballot, the members who received the greater number of votes are to serve the longer term of office, and those with the lesser number of votes are to serve the shorter term of office;
 - (b) if paragraph (a) does not apply:
 - (i) the members in the affected membership category may determine which of their number are to serve the longer terms of office, and which are to serve the shorter terms of office:

(ii) if no agreement can be reached, the matter is to be determined by the drawing of lots.

21. Terms of office – subsequent school council elections

Unless otherwise provided in this Order, the term of office for all members elected or co-opted to a school council at subsequent school council elections:

- (a) commences (as the case may be) on:
 - (i) the day after the date of the declaration of the poll for the election at which they were elected; or
 - (ii) the day they are co-opted; and
- (b) ends on the date of the declaration of the poll for the election to be held in the second calendar year following the year of their election or co-option or, if no election is held in that year, on 31 March of that year.

22. Nominee member category

- (1) The terms of office for members appointed to the nominee member category of a school council is the term of office specified in column 3 of the Table in Schedule 4 (if any).
- (2) If no term of office is specified in column 3 of the Table in Schedule 4, then a person appointed to the nominee member category continues in office, subject to clause 24, until the authorised appointer for that position, by notice in writing to the principal, revokes the appointment or appoints another person to that office.

Division 5 – School council elections

23. Election provisions

- (1) Schedule 6 makes provision for school council elections.
- (2) Schedule 7 prescribes forms for use during the election process.

Division 6 – Casual vacancies

24. Creation of casual vacancies

- (1) A casual vacancy is created when a member of a school council (other than the principal):
 - (a) resigns in writing to:
 - (i) the principal of the school; or
 - (ii) the president of the school council;
 - (b) ceases to be eligible for election, co-option or appointment to the relevant membership category;
 - (c) is absent from three consecutive school council meetings without the prior leave

of the council;

- (d) in the case of a school employee member, takes leave of any kind from employment with the Department (including secondment), with or without pay, for a period of more than six months;
- (e) in the parent member category, becomes a Department employee during their term of office in circumstances that would cause the school council's membership size and composition to be inconsistent with clause 16;
- (f) who is a member of another membership category is appointed as a nominee member of the school council;
- (g) who is a nominee member becomes a parent member, school employee member, or community member of the school council; or
- (h) is found to have been ineligible for election, co-option, or appointment to the council at the time of their election, co-option, or appointment.

(2) Despite subclause (1)(b), if:

- (a) a student member of the school council ceases to be enrolled at the school having completed the normal school year for the student's year level, the student may continue to be a member of the school council until the next school council election;
- (b) a student ceases to be enrolled at the school having completed the normal school year for the student's year level and that student's parent is a parent member of the school council, the parent may continue to be a member of the school council until the next school council election.
- (3) If a member of the school council (other than the principal) is subsequently appointed as the principal of the school, except in the case of a temporary appointment, a casual vacancy is created in relation to their previous position.
- (4) For the purposes of subclause (3), an appointment is not temporary that is for more than 12 continuous weeks.

25. Filling casual vacancies

- (1) A casual vacancy in a membership category other than the nominee member category must be filled by the school council co-opting an eligible person to the relevant membership category for the unexpired portion of the vacating member's term of office.
- (2) Casual vacancies in a nominee member category must be filled by the authorised appointer for the position making a new appointment for the unexpired portion (if any) of the vacating member's term of office.

Division 7 – Miscellaneous provisions

26. Office bearers

- (1) A Department employee may not serve as the president or vice-president of the school council (including in an acting capacity).
- (2) A student member may not serve as the president, vice-president or treasurer of the school council (including in an acting capacity).

Note: Regulation 33 of the *Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017* sets out the process for the election of office bearers.

27. Effect of vacancy or irregularities

- (1) The school council may not conduct any school council meeting unless the quorum requirements for school council meetings in regulations 28 to 31 of the *Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017* are satisfied.
- (2) Subject to subclause (1), the school council is properly constituted even though the total number of school council members has not been appointed.
- (3) An act or a decision of the school council is not invalid solely because of:
 - (a) a vacancy in the office of a member; or
 - (b) a defect or irregularity in or in connection with the election, co-option or appointment of a member.

Part 4 – Powers, duties and functions of school councils

28. Powers, duties and functions of school councils

The powers, duties and functions conferred or imposed on a school council by or under this Part:

- (a) are in addition to those conferred or imposed on that school council by or under the Act; and
- (b) are subject to any limitations or stipulations provided for in this Part.

Note: If there is any conflict between the Act and the Ministerial Order, the Act will prevail.

29. Banking and finance

- (1) A school council must comply with the Finance Manual for Victorian Government Schools.
- (2) In performing its functions to procure, or arrange for the supply of, banking services under section 2.3.5(b) of the Act, a school council must do so in accordance with the whole of Victorian government central banking system except where the school council is exempt in the circumstances set out in the Finance Manual for Victorian Government Schools.

(3) In this clause:

Finance Manual for Victorian Government Schools means the document setting out the financial arrangements established by the Secretary under Direction 2.3.5 of the Standing Directions issued under section 8 of the Financial Management Act 1994 (as amended or remade from time to time);

whole of Victorian government central banking system means the banking arrangements and services provided for under the State Purchase Contract between the State of Victoria acting through the Department of Treasury and Finance and the Westpac Banking Corporation (ABN 33 007 457 141), which commenced on 1 October 2011 (as amended from time to time).

30. School council may purchase goods, services, equipment or materials

- (1) In performing its function under section 2.3.5(b) of the Act to purchase goods, services, equipment, or materials, a school council must comply with:
 - (a) the Procurement Policy for Victorian Government Schools;
 - (b) the purchasing thresholds in the Schools Procurement Procedure issued by the Secretary (and amended from time to time); and
 - (c) the record-keeping requirements of the **Public Records Act 1973**.
- (2) The school council must not, without the prior written approval of the Secretary, purchase:
 - (a) a vehicle; or
 - (b) goods or services in a mandated Department-managed category of goods or services from a supplier that is not a nominated supplier for that category of goods or services.

Note: Prior approval under this clause is not required in respect of purchasing from suppliers for which there is no Department-managed category of goods or services or where the Department-managed category is mandated but optional.

(3) For the purpose of subclause (2):

mandated Department-managed category of goods or services has the same meaning as in the Procurement Policy for Victorian Government Schools;

nominated supplier, in respect of any mandated Department-managed category, has the same meaning as in the Procurement Policy for Victorian Government Schools;

vehicle has the same meaning as in the Road Safety Act 1986.

31. Power to purchase by use of purchasing card facilities

- (1) A school council may enter into arrangements with an approved financial institution under which the school council may purchase goods, services, equipment, or materials using purchasing card facilities provided by the financial institution.
- (2) The purchase by a school council of goods, services, equipment, or materials using purchasing card facilities must:
 - (a) be for a school-related purpose; and
 - (b) comply with:
 - (i) any applicable guidelines and directions issued by the Minister under section 5.2.1 of the Act;
 - (ii) any applicable policies or procedures about the school council's use of purchasing cards issued by the Secretary (as amended from time to time); and
 - (iii) the terms and conditions relating to the use of any purchasing card issued by the financial institution to the school council (as amended from time to time).
- (3) In subclause (1), "approved" means approved by the Secretary.

32. Hire equipment

- (1) A school council may enter into an agreement for the hire of equipment for use at the school if the sole or primary purpose of entering into the agreement is to:
 - (a) benefit the education of students at the school; or
 - (b) assist with the efficient conduct or operation of the school.
- (2) In exercising its power under subclause (1), a school council must:
 - (a) comply with:
 - (i) the Procurement Policy for Victorian Government Schools;
 - (ii) all applicable purchasing thresholds in the Schools Procurement Procedure issued by the Secretary (and amended from time to time);
 - (b) follow an appropriate procurement process;
 - (c) comply with the record-keeping requirements of the **Public Records Act 1973**; and
 - (d) arrange appropriate insurance coverage for the hired equipment (either through the terms of the hire agreement or by a separate insurance policy).
- (3) In exercising its power under subclause (1), a school council must not:
 - (a) enter into an agreement for a continuous period exceeding four years without the prior written approval of the Regional Director;
 - (b) enter into an agreement for the hire or use of equipment previously owned by the school council or the Department;
 - (c) commit funds of a non-recurrent nature or funds granted for a specific purpose towards the costs of an agreement until the donor or provider of the funds has consented to that in writing; or
 - (d) enter into an agreement unless it is satisfied that it will be able to meet all of its financial obligations under the agreement.
- (4) A school council must report the details of every equipment agreement that it has entered into at the school council's public reporting meeting.
- (5) The report referred to in subclause (4) must include:
 - (a) a description of the equipment hired;
 - (b) the purpose for which it was hired;
 - (c) the duration of the hire; and
 - (d) the cost of the hire agreement.
- (6) The costs of each hire agreement must be fully identified in the school council's audited statement of receipts and expenditure that is presented to the school council's public reporting meeting.
- (7) Subclauses (3) to (6) do not apply to:
 - (a) the hire of a video recording; or

(b) the hire of any other thing for a period of less than four weeks in any one calendar year where the cost of the hire is less than \$1,500.

(8) In this clause:

- (a) *equipment* includes goods and products but does not include fixtures;
- (b) *equipment agreement* means a contract to hire equipment, or a licence to use equipment, under which:
 - (i) the school council has the right to use the equipment;
 - (ii) there is no option, right, or obligation of the school council or any other person to buy the equipment; and
 - (iii) the school council is required, at the end of the contract or licence, to return the equipment to the other party to the contract or licence.

33. Fundraising

A school council may raise funds for the school by conducting local efforts or staging entertainments or amusements.

34. Gifts

A school council may accept gifts for and on behalf of a school for which it is constituted (including real estate) provided that any encumbrance or condition that attaches to the gift is approved by the Secretary before the school council accepts the gift.

35. Installation and operation of CCTV

A school council, in exercising any powers and functions it may have in relation to the installation and operation of CCTV, must comply with any applicable policies issued by the Department (and amended from time to time) in relation to the installation and operation of CCTV.

36. Cleaning of schools

In discharging its function under section 2.3.5(f) of the Act, a school council must comply with any applicable policy and procedure issued by the Department (as amended from time to time) for school cleaning services.

37. Power to grant licences

For the purposes of section 2.3.6(1)(ca) of the Act, a school council may grant a licence in relation to lands or buildings of the school for one or more of the following purposes:

- (a) to meet the objectives, and perform the functions or duties, of the school council; or
- (b) for educational, recreational, sporting or cultural activities for students, the local community or young persons.

Note: See section 2.3.21 of the Act regarding the power to licence land for use to operate a preschool program or programs for children.

38. Use of school buildings and grounds

In exercising its powers under sections 2.3.6(1)(ca), 2.3.11 or 2.3.21 of the Act in relation to the use of school buildings and grounds, the school council must:

- (a) comply with any applicable policies or procedures issued by the Department (and amended from time to time); and
- (b) ensure that appropriate insurance coverage is maintained in relation to the use of the school buildings and grounds and any activities conducted in or on those school buildings or grounds.

39. Power to provide goods, services or facilities

- (1) A school council may enter into an arrangement or agreement, for reward or otherwise, to provide goods, services, or facilities to other Government schools or educational institutions if:
 - (a) doing so also assists in the efficient conduct of a school for which the school council was constituted; and
 - (b) the arrangement or agreement is for the provision of goods, services, or facilities that the council would be permitted by or under the Act to procure if the school or institution were a school for which the council was constituted.
- (2) An arrangement or agreement under subclause (1) must comply with any applicable policies or procedures issued by the Secretary (as amended from time to time).

40. Construction works

In accordance with section 2.3.12 of the Act, a school council may:

- (a) construct or carry out any improvements to any building structure on the school grounds, or carry out any improvements in or to the school grounds, where the value of the structure or improvements does not exceed \$50,000; or
- (b) enter into a contract for carrying out any other work that the council is authorised or required by or under the Act to carry out where the value of the contract does not exceed \$50.000.

provided that the school council complies with any applicable policies or procedures issued by the Department (and amended from time to time).

41. Early childhood services

- (1) The school council of a school that provides primary school education may apply for a licence or an approval under the **Children's Services Act 1996** or the Education and Care Services National Law (Vic) to operate an early childhood service solely or together with another school council, person, or body:
 - (a) on the school's premises; or
 - (b) with the Minister's permission, on other premises under the control of the Minister.
- (2) If an application referred to in subclause (1) is granted by the relevant authority, the school council may:

- (a) operate the early childhood service on the premises referred to in subclause (1) and require payment of fees for that and other related services; or
- (b) enter into a licence agreement or, subject to prior written approval by the Minister, a lease with another person for that person to use the premises referred to in subclause (1) to provide an early childhood service on behalf of the school council or on the licensee or lessee's own account.
- (3) A school council may carry out improvements to school buildings and grounds as needed to facilitate the provision of an early childhood service under this clause.
- (4) In this clause, early childhood service means:
 - (a) an education and care service within the meaning of the Education and Care Services National Law (Vic); or
 - (b) a children's service within the meaning of the Children's Services Act 1996.

Note:

Subclause (3) is subject to section 2.3.12 of the Act, which deals with the power of a school council to carry out works.

42. School plan

For the purposes of section 2.3.24(1) of the Act:

- (a) a school's goals and targets include the school's philosophy; and
- (b) a school plan must be prepared in accordance with any guidelines issued by the Department (and amended from time to time).

43. Curriculum planning

- (1) Subject to subclause (2), in the performance of its powers and functions, a school council does not determine the curriculum programs to be followed in the school.
- (2) The school council may, in accordance with its function under section 2.3.5(i) of the Act to inform itself and take into account the views of the school community, advise the principal of its views regarding curriculum programs to be followed in the school.

Note:

Clause 11.2.2(4) of Ministerial Order No. 1038 - Teaching Service (Employment Conditions, Salaries, Allowances, Selection and Conduct) Order 2017 gives the principal of the school primary responsibility for the determination (after consideration of the general education policy of the school and consultation with employees at the school) of the curriculum programs to be followed in the school.

44. Student dress

- (1) The council may determine a student dress code for students of the school while they are:
 - (a) at school;
 - (b) travelling to and from school; and
 - (c) attending school activities.
- (2) A student dress code may provide for any matters that the school council considers appropriate in relation to clothing, other items worn, carried or used by students, grooming, physical appearance, and the general presentation of students, including:

- (a) whether a school uniform may or must be worn by students, and the school uniform to be worn;
- (b) clothing (including shoes) to be worn during classes and specified school activities such as sport, laboratory experiments, and extra-curricular activities;
- (c) the school bags to be used by students;
- (d) the grounds on which any student may be exempted from complying with the dress code; and
- (e) how the dress code may be enforced.
- (3) For the purposes of subclause (2)(e), the enforcement of a student dress code must be consistent with the school's student code of conduct, section 2.2.19 of the Act, and any Order made for the purposes of that section.
- (4) A school council may enter into a contract with any person for the supply of school uniforms for students of the school.

45. International education services and programs

- (1) In the exercise and performance of its powers, functions, and duties, a school council must comply with any policies or procedures issued by the Department (and amended from time to time) in relation to the provision of international education services and programs, including policies or procedures in relation to:
 - (a) the provision of education to overseas students;
 - (b) arrangements for inbound or outbound study tours or overseas student exchange programs; or
 - (c) local, interstate, or international homestay arrangements.
- (2) If the school is accredited by the Department to deliver an International Student Program in accordance with the **Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000** (**Cth**), the principal must, at least once every 12 months, make a report to the school council on the school's compliance with its obligations under that Act.

46. Responsibilities in relation to the reportable conduct scheme under the Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005

- (1) The principal of the school must ensure that:
 - (a) the school council is made aware of the Department's system for preventing the commission of reportable conduct by an employee of the school council;
 - (b) any notification of a reportable allegation that is required to be made under section 16M of the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005** is to be made in accordance with subclause (4).
- (2) The school council must enact a system that enables any person, including a member or employee of the school council, to notify the principal of a reportable allegation.
- (3) The principal and the school council (as the case requires) must use the Department's system for investigating and responding to any reportable allegation against an employee of the school council.
- (4) To enable the Secretary to notify the Commission for Children and Young People of, and to investigate and respond to, a reportable allegation in a Victorian Government school as required by the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005**, the principal must:

- (a) as soon as possible after becoming aware of a reportable allegation against an employee of the school council, notify a nominee of the Secretary and provide information about:
 - (i) the identity of the employee against whom the allegation has been made; and
 - (ii) whether Victoria Police has been contacted about the allegation;
- (b) as soon as practicable after the school council decides to take disciplinary or other action (including no action) in relation to the employee against whom the reportable allegation has been made, provide information to the nominee of the Secretary about the action taken and the decision-maker's reasons for taking that action; and
- (c) as soon as practicable, notify the nominee of the Secretary of any request received (by the school council or the principal) from the Commission for Children and Young People concerning documents, information, visits, or interviews that relate to a reportable allegation or reportable conduct.
- (5) Subclause (4) does not apply if the school belongs to a class of entities that is exempted from the application of all or part of Part 5A of the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005**.
- (6) In this clause:

"employee", in relation to a school council, has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005**;

"nominee of the Secretary" refers to the positions (including any successor position) of:

- (a) Executive Director, People Division; or
- (b) Manager, Employee Conduct Branch, People Division;

"reportable allegation" has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005**; and

"reportable conduct" has the same meaning as in section 3(1) of the **Child Wellbeing and Safety Act 2005**.

47. Transport Accident Commission agreements

A school council may enter into one or more agreements with the Transport Accident Commission concerning the provision of staff, facilities, equipment, support, or other services for a student of the school who is the subject of a claim under the **Transport Accident Act 1986**.

48. Annual reports

For the purposes of section 2.3.27(2)(a) and (b) of the Act, the school council's annual report must be:

- (a) prepared and provided to the Secretary by 30 April in the calendar year after the calendar year to which it relates; and
- (b) prepared in accordance with any standards and guidelines issued by the Department (and amended from time to time).

Part 5 – General

49. Transitional provision in relation to membership of existing school councils

Subject to clauses 17, 18, 19, and 24, a person who, immediately before the commencement date, was a member of an existing school council, continues to be a member of the school council on the same terms and for the same period.

50. Revocation

- (1) In this clause, **government school council** means a school council that was constituted under section 2.3.2 of the Act or section 13(1) of the **Education Act 1958** in relation to one or more Government schools.
- (2) The constituting orders of all government school councils that were in force immediately before the commencement of this clause are revoked except the constituting orders of the school councils of the following schools:
 - (a) Baringhup Primary School;
 - (b) Clarkefield Primary School;
 - (c) Dargo Primary School;
 - (d) Devon North Primary School;
 - (e) Invergordon Primary School;
 - (f) Meerlieu Primary School;
 - (g) Stanley Primary School.
- (3) The following orders are also revoked:
 - (a) Ministerial Orders No 38 and 108: Order amending the Constituting Orders of the School Councils of all State Schools
 - (b) Ministerial Order No 52: School Council Composition and Elections Order;
 - (c) Ministerial Order No 53: Order amending the Constituting Orders of the School Councils of all Government Schools (2008);
 - (d) Ministerial Order No 198: Order amending Ministerial Order 52 (2009);
 - (e) Ministerial Order No 311: Order amending Ministerial Order 52 (2010);
 - (f) Ministerial Order No 383: Order amending the Constituting Orders of Government School Councils (2010);
 - (g) Ministerial Order No 399: Order amending Ministerial Order 52 (2010);
 - (h) Ministerial Order No 470 School Plan and Annual Report Order (2011);
 - (i) Ministerial Order No 487: Order amending Ministerial Order 52 (2011);
 - (j) Ministerial Order No 784 Amendment to School Plan and Annual Report Order (2015);
 - (k) Ministerial Order No 928 Power of School Council to Grant a Licence in Relation to School Lands or Buildings (2016);

Election provisions

Part 1 – Notice of elections and nominations

1. Interpretation

In this Schedule:

date fixed for the closure of the ballot means the date fixed by the principal under clause 2 of this Schedule;

first day of the school year means the date determined by the Minister under regulation 13 of the Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017 as the first day on which a school is required to be open for attendance by students for the school year.

2. Election date must be fixed

The principal must:

- (a) (i) on or after the first day of the school year, fix a date for the closure of the ballot for the election of school council members unless directed otherwise by the Secretary; or
 - (ii) if this Order otherwise requires an election to be held, fix a date for the closure of the ballot for that election; and
- (b) prepare an electoral roll for use in the election.

Note: The date for the declaration for the poll under paragraph (a)(i) must be on or before 31 March. Nominations must be invited 21 days before the closure of the ballot. Nominations must be received on or before the 14th day before the date fixed for the closure of the ballot.

3. Notices of elections and calls for nominations

- (1) At least 21 days before the date fixed for closure of the ballot, the principal must invite nominations of candidates by:
 - (a) sending a *Notice of Election and Call for Nominations* to all of the eligible voters in the electorates to be contested; and
 - (b) causing a copy of the *Notice of Election and Call for Nominations* to be posted in at least one prominent location at the school.
- (2) The *Notice of Election and Call for Nominations* must:
 - (a) in the case of the first school council election, be in form 1 of Schedule 7; or
 - (b) in the case of any subsequent election, be in form 2 of Schedule 7.

4. Nomination of candidates

(1) A person who is a member of the school employee electorate may nominate themselves or another member of that electorate (except the principal) as a candidate for the school

employee member category.

- (2) A person who is a member of the parent electorate may nominate themselves or another member of that electorate as a candidate for the parent member category.
- (3) A person who is a member of the secondary school student electorate may nominate themselves or another member of that electorate as a candidate for the student member category.
- (4) A person may nominate a candidate for election by delivering a candidate nomination form to the principal before the close of nominations.
- (5) The candidate nomination form for:
 - (a) a self-nominating candidate for the parent member category must be in form 3 of Schedule 7:
 - (b) a candidate for the parent member category must be in form 4 of Schedule 7;
 - (c) a self-nominating candidate for the school employee member category must be in form 5 of Schedule 7;
 - (d) a candidate for the school employee member category must be in form 6 of Schedule 7;
 - (e) a self-nominating candidate for the student member category must be in form 7 of Schedule 7; and
 - (f) a candidate for the student member category must be in form 8 of Schedule 7.
- (6) The principal must ensure that sufficient candidate nomination forms are available at the school.
- (7) All nominations must be received by 4 pm on the 14th day before the date fixed for the closure of the ballot (the "close of nominations").
- (8) The principal must, as soon as practicable after receiving a valid nomination, post a receipt of that nomination in form 9 of Schedule 7:
 - (a) to each candidate; and
 - (b) unless the candidate nominated themselves, to each nominator.
- (9) The principal must ensure that each completed nomination form is kept at the school, and made available for inspection by voters at reasonable times:
 - (a) until voting commences; and
 - (b) for one year from the date of the declaration of the poll.

5. Candidates

- (1) A candidate must be a person who is eligible for election in the membership category.
- (2) The principal may require:
 - (a) a candidate to produce evidence of their eligibility for election;

- (b) a nominator or voter to produce evidence of their eligibility to vote in the relevant electorate.
- (3) A candidate, nominator or voter (as the case may be) must comply with a request under subclause (1) within the time frame determined by the principal.
- (4) The principal must reject a nomination if the principal determines that:
 - (a) a candidate is ineligible for election; or
 - (b) the nominator is ineligible to vote.
- (5) A candidate may stand for election in only one position in any election (regardless of the number of nominations received).

6. Principal must post notice of candidates

The principal must cause a notice to be posted in a prominent position at the school, as soon as practicable after the close of nominations, showing:

- (a) the names of each candidate; and
- (b) the names of each person who nominated the candidate.

7. Electioneering

- (1) If the principal declares an eligible member of the secondary school student electorate to be a candidate for the student member category, the candidate may distribute or post campaign literature in the school in accordance with any school policy (as determined by the principal).
- (2) Subject to subclause (1):
 - (a) no other campaign literature (whether supporting a particular candidate or groups of candidates for a school council election) may be distributed or posted in the school; and
 - (b) school resources, whether human or material, may not be used to support particular candidates or groups of candidates.

Part 2 - Voting

8. Ballot papers

- (1) If the principal is required to hold an election, invite a second round of nominations or hold a run-off election, the principal must:
 - (a) cause ballot papers to be prepared with the names of the candidates standing for election in the relevant membership category, in an order determined by drawing lots;
 - (b) ensure that each ballot paper is marked in a manner that is easily authenticated (by, for example, a signature or school stamp);

- (c) at least seven days before the date fixed for the closure of the ballot, arrange for each member of the relevant electorate or electorates to receive (by post, by delivery, or by hand) a ballot paper for the election of candidates for that electorate together with:
 - (i) an envelope for enclosing and sealing the ballot paper (the inner envelope); and
 - (ii) another envelope for posting the ballot paper to the school (the outer envelope);
- (d) ensure that a sealed ballot box is available at the school for the casting of the votes at the school between the hours of 8 am and 4 pm on every school day up to and including the date fixed for the close of the ballot;
- (e) ensure that a register is maintained for recording the name and address of every voter;
- (f) if a vote is received by post or delivery, place the unopened inner envelope containing the completed ballot paper in the ballot box; and
- (g) ensure that the ballot box is kept in a secure place at all times.
- (2) A ballot paper referred to in subclause (1)(a) must be in the form prescribed in:
 - (a) form 10 or 12 of Schedule 7 (as applicable) if the election is in relation to the parent member category;
 - (b) form 11 of Schedule 7 if the election is in relation to the school employee member category; or
 - (c) form 13 of Schedule 7 if the election is in relation to the student member category.

9. Voting procedure

- (1) To cast a vote, a voter must:
 - (a) place a mark on a ballot paper next to the name of a candidate standing for election in the relevant category, up to the number of vacancies to be filled;
 - (b) place the ballot paper in a blank envelope;
 - (c) either:
 - place the blank envelope into a ballot box made available at the school by the principal and print the voter's name and address on the register of voters; or
 - (ii) place the blank envelope into another envelope (outer envelope) and:
 - (A) post the outer envelope to the principal at the school so that it arrives by 4 pm on the date fixed for the closure of the ballot; or

(B) arrange for the outer envelope to be delivered to the principal, or a school staff member authorised by the principal, between the hours of 8 am and 4 pm on any school day on or before the date fixed for the closure of the ballot.

(2) A voter:

- (a) must not submit more than one ballot paper; and
- (b) may vote for as many candidates in the relevant category as there are vacancies to be filled

(3) Only members of:

- (a) the parent electorate of the school may vote for candidates standing for election to the parent member category of the school council;
- (b) the school employee electorate of the school may vote for candidates standing for election to the school employee member category of the school council;
- (c) the secondary school student electorate of the school may vote for candidates standing for election to the student member category of the school council.
- (4) If the principal determines that it is appropriate, the school may pay the return postage for a ballot paper posted under subclause (1)(c)(ii)(A).

10. Invalid votes

- (1) A ballot paper is invalid if it:
 - (a) is not received by the principal, or placed in the ballot box, by 4 pm on the date fixed for the closure of the ballot;
 - (b) is not properly and clearly marked;
 - (c) except as provided in subclause (2), contains more marks for candidates than there are vacancies; or
 - (d) does not otherwise comply with this Order.
- (2) If an election is held concurrently for:
 - (a) candidates to the parent member category who are not Department employees; and
 - (b) candidates to the parent member category who are Department employees; and there are more marks than candidates for one subcategory but not the other, the ballot paper is only invalid in relation to the subcategory for which the number of marks exceeds the number of vacancies.

11. Receipt of nomination or ballot papers

- (1) The principal is not required to locate or identify any member of an electorate for the purposes of posting or arranging delivery of the notice of election and call for nominations or ballot papers, other than from information:
 - (a) found in the usual records kept at the school; or
 - (b) provided to the principal by the member, in writing.
- (2) A failure or omission to provide a notice of election and call for nominations or ballot paper to any member of the electorate of the school does not invalidate the election of any member to the school council.

12. Counting procedures

- (1) The principal must preside at the counting of the votes on:
 - (a) the date fixed for the closure of the ballot; or
 - (b) a day as soon as practicable after that date.
- (2) The principal must inform each candidate standing for election of:
 - (a) the date, time, and place for the counting of the votes; and
 - (b) their right to appoint one scrutineer to observe the counting of the votes.
- (3) The principal must appoint two or more tellers, who must not be one of the candidates for election or a scrutineer appointed under subclause (2)(b), to:
 - (a) count the number of votes cast for each candidate:
 - (b) report the results to the principal; and
 - (c) carry out any other duties, in respect of the election, required by the principal.
- (4) Subject to subclause (5), votes must be counted in the presence of any appointed scrutineers.
- (5) The principal must ensure that any scrutineer who interferes with the counting procedures is immediately removed from the place where the votes are being counted.
- (6) At the conclusion of the counting of the votes, the principal must:
 - (a) rank the candidates in each category in order of the total number of votes received by each candidate;
 - (b) if there is a tie between some or all of the candidates standing for election in any membership category, determine the ranking of the respective candidates by the drawing of lots; and
 - (c) if requested by an interested person, disclose the rankings and the number of votes received by each candidate.

13. Student member category and school employee member category

- (1) This clause applies to elections for:
 - (a) the student member category; and
 - (b) the school employee member category.

Vacancies equal to candidates

(2) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the relevant category is equal to the number of vacancies, the principal must declare each candidate elected and inform the school community.

Fewer candidates than vacancies

- (3) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the relevant category is fewer than the number of vacancies, the principal must:
 - (a) declare every candidate elected and inform the school community; and
 - (b) invite another round of nominations for the remaining (unfilled) positions.
- (4) If, after the second round of nominations under subclause (3)(b), the number of candidates is:
 - (a) equal to the number of remaining positions, the principal must declare those candidates elected and inform the school community;
 - (b) fewer than the number of remaining positions, the principal must declare those candidates elected and the council must co-opt eligible persons to fill any positions that still remain unfilled;
 - (c) exceeds the number of remaining positions, the principal must hold a run-off election among the candidates for those remaining positions.

More candidates than vacancies

(5) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the relevant category exceeds the number of vacancies, the principal must hold a run-off election among the candidates.

14. Parent member category

(1) This clause applies to elections for the parent member category.

Vacancies equal to candidates, maximum Department employees not exceeded

(2) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category is equal to the number of vacancies, and the maximum number of Department employee parents is not exceeded, then the principal must declare each candidate elected and inform the school community.

Fewer candidates than vacancies, number of Department employees equal to maximum number

- (3) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category is less than the number of vacancies, and the number of Department employee parents is equal to the maximum number of Department employee parents, the principal must:
 - (a) declare every candidate elected and inform the school community; and
 - (b) invite another round of nominations for the remaining (non-Department employee parent) positions.
- (4) If, after the second round of nominations under subclause (3)(b), the number of candidates for the remaining non-Department employee parent positions is:
 - (a) equal to the number of remaining positions, the principal must declare those candidates elected and inform the school community;
 - (b) less than the number of remaining positions:
 - (i) the principal must declare those candidates elected and inform the school community; and
 - (ii) the council must co-opt eligible persons to fill the positions that still remain unfilled;
 - (c) exceeds the number of remaining positions, the principal must hold a run-off election among those candidates for those remaining positions.

Fewer candidates than vacancies, number of Department employees exceeds maximum number

- (5) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category is less than the number of vacancies but the number of Department employees is more than the maximum number of Department employee parents, the principal must:
 - (a) declare every non-Department employee parent candidate elected and inform the school community;
 - (b) hold a run-off election among the Department employee parent candidates; and
 - (c) invite another round of nominations for the remaining (non-Department employee parent) positions.
- (6) If, after the second round of nominations under subclause (5)(c), the number of candidates for the remaining non-Department employee parent positions is:
 - (a) equal to the number of remaining positions, the principal must declare those candidates elected and inform the school community;
 - (b) less than the number of remaining positions:
 - (i) the principal must declare those candidates elected and inform the school community; and

- (ii) the council must co-opt eligible persons to fill the positions that still remain unfilled;
- (c) exceeds the number of remaining positions, the principal must hold a run-off election among those candidates for the remaining positions.

Fewer candidates than vacancies, number of Department employees is less than maximum number

- (7) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category is less than the number of vacancies, and the number of Department employee parents is less than the maximum number, the principal must:
 - (a) declare every candidate elected and inform the school community; and
 - (b) invite another round of nominations for the remaining (unfilled) positions.
- (8) If, after the second round of nominations under subclause (7)(b):
 - (a) the number of candidates is equal to or less than the number of remaining positions and the maximum number of Department employee parents would not be exceeded:
 - (i) the principal must declare all of those candidates elected and inform the school community; and
 - (ii) the council must co-opt eligible persons to fill the positions that still remain unfilled;
 - (b) the number of candidates exceeds the number of vacancies but only because the number of candidates who are Department employees exceeds the maximum number of Department employee parents, the principal must:
 - (i) declare every non-Department employee parent candidate elected and inform the school community; and
 - (ii) hold a run-off election among the Department employees; or
 - (c) the number of candidates exceeds the number of vacancies but paragraph (b) does not apply:
 - (i) the principal must hold a run-off election among all the candidates; and
 - (ii) the candidates are to be elected in the order of the number of votes they receive in the second round of votes until all the positions are filled (subject to the maximum number of Department employees not being exceeded).

More candidates than vacancies, number of non-Department employees is equal to the minimum number, the number of Department employees is more than maximum number

(9) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category exceeds the number of vacancies but only because the number of candidates who are Department employees exceeds the maximum number of Department employee parents, the principal must:

- (a) declare every non-Department employee parent candidate elected and inform the school community; and
- (b) hold a run-off election among the Department employees.

More candidates than vacancies for reason other than Department employees exceeding the maximum number

- (10) If, at the close of nominations, the number of candidates for the parent category exceeds the number of vacancies and subclause (9) does not apply:
 - (a) the principal must hold a run-off election among all the candidates; and
 - (b) the candidates are to be elected in the order of the number of votes they receive in the second round of votes until all the positions are filled (subject to the maximum number of Department employees not being exceeded).

15. Second round of nominations

- (1) If clause 13 or 14 requires a second round of nominations, the principal must immediately post a notice in a prominent position in the school:
 - (a) stating that an insufficient number of nominations were received in the first round of nominations; and
 - (b) calling for further nominations to be lodged for the relevant category within three school days.
- (2) Only (eligible) persons who were not nominated in the first round of nominations may stand for election in the second round of nominations.
- (3) If a second round of nominations is required to be held for more than one electorate, those rounds are to be held, where possible, at the same time.

16. Run-off elections

- (1) If clause 13 or 14 requires a run-off election, the principal must:
 - (a) immediately post a notice, in a prominent position in the school, stating that, in the first or second round of nominations (as the case may be), there were more nominations than there were vacancies for the relevant category (or subcategory); and
 - (b) cause ballot papers to be prepared with the names of the candidates contesting the run-off election.
- (2) At the conclusion of the counting of the votes, the principal must:
 - (a) rank the candidates in order of the total number of votes received by each candidate;
 - (b) if there is a tie between some or all of the candidates standing for election in any membership category, determine the ranking of the respective candidates by the drawing of lots;

- (c) if requested by any interested person, disclose the rankings and the number of votes received by each candidate; and
- (d) declare the highest-ranking candidates to be elected up to the number of vacancies to be filled (subject to the maximum number of Department employees not being exceeded).

Division 3 – Post election

17. Declaration of the poll

- (1) After an election is completed (including any second round of nominations and run-off elections), the principal must call a meeting of the council to:
 - (a) formally declare the candidates elected to the council; and
 - (b) report on the number of votes cast by each electorate of the school.
- (2) The principal must ensure that the poll is declared:
 - (a) in the case of an annual school election, no later than 31 March of the year in which the election is held; or
 - (b) in the case of any other election, as soon as practicable after the counting of the votes (for all rounds).
- (3) The declaration of the poll may coincide with any other school council meeting.

18. Unfilled vacancies

- (1) If any elected positions remain unfilled after an election is completed (including a second round of nominations and run-off elections), the school council must co-opt eligible persons to the relevant membership category.
- (2) A person is eligible to be co-opted to a membership category under this clause if the person is eligible to be elected to the membership category (subject to the maximum number of Department employees not being exceeded).

Note:

Regulation 32 of the Education and Training Reform Regulations 2017 sets out the process for co-opting community members.

19. Notifications

- (1) The principal must notify the school community of the names of:
 - (a) new members of the school council as soon as practicable after the members have been elected or co-opted; and
 - (b) new office holders (i.e. president, vice-president, or treasurer) as soon as practicable after their appointment to office.
- (2) The principal must notify all persons standing for election of the results of the election within 48 hours of the declaration of the poll.

- (3) The principal must notify the Secretary of the names of new members and office holders by submitting a completed return:
 - (a) in a form approved by the Secretary; and
 - (b) by the end of April in the year in which the election takes place.

20. Records should be kept

The principal must ensure that all ballot papers, results and related information are:

- (a) retained at the school for one year; and
- (b) destroyed at the end of a period of one year after the date of the declaration of the poll unless the principal has been instructed otherwise by the Secretary.

Division 4 – Disputes and complaints

21. Disputes during an election

The principal has the power to decide any dispute that arises during the election.

22. Complaints about the conduct of an election

- (1) Any person who is aggrieved by any matter arising out of the conduct of an election may, within 14 days of the date of the declaration of the poll, make a complaint in writing to the principal.
- (2) The principal must, as soon as is practicable, refer any complaint received under subclause (1) to the relevant Regional Director.
- (3) The Regional Director must establish a committee consisting of:
 - (a) a member of the regional office nominated by the Regional Director;
 - (b) the president of the school council or a parent member of the school council who does not have a conflict of interest; and
 - (c) a school employee member of the school council who does not have a conflict of interest.
- (4) For the purpose of clause (3), a person is taken to have a conflict of interest if the matter involves or affects them or a close relative of theirs.
- (5) If the committee cannot, within 14 days of its establishment, agree on how the complaint should be dealt with, the committee must refer the matter to the Regional Director for determination.
- (6) Until a determination of the committee or the Regional Director:
 - (a) an election in respect of which a complaint is made is to be regarded as valid; and

- (b) any decision made by the school council during that interval is not invalid solely because of any defect or irregularity in the election process.
- (7) If the committee or the Regional Director determines that a fresh election is required, any decision made by the school council from the date of the determination to the date of the new election is not invalid solely because of any defect or irregularity in the election process.
